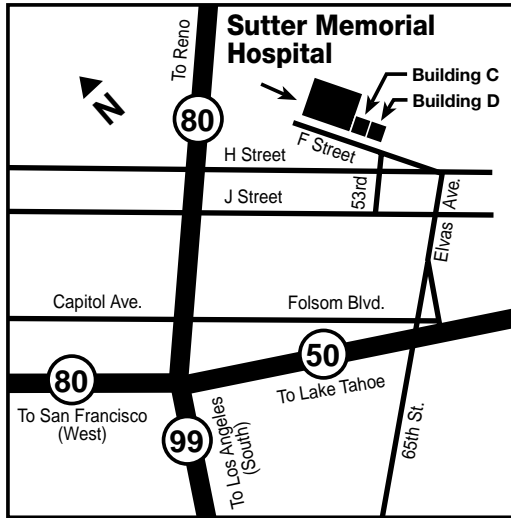

Cystic Fibrosis Center

The Cystic Fibrosis (CF) Center is designed with children and their families in mind. The center provides ongoing care from initial diagnosis to adulthood, helping patients maintain their emotional well-being and achieve their highest level of physical growth and activity.

The center's interdisciplinary team is made up of a pediatric pulmonologist, pediatric gastroenterologist, pediatric nurse practitioner, social workers, dieticians, and respiratory therapists. The center also maintains strong liaisons with other pediatric subspecialists and Children's Center services that provide aspects of care for CF patients.

Acting as a central coordination point, the center's core team designs and refines a treatment plan that addresses each child's specific needs. Center staff coordinates all aspects of a child's care, including educating families about cystic fibrosis and how to care for a child at home. Patients come to the clinic once every quarter and receive an assessment of their physical, nutritional, emotional, social and respiratory needs, as well as their response to previous treatments. During hospital stays, center staff visits regularly and stays in constant communication with hospital doctors and nursing staff. The center also provides pulmonary function testing, sleep studies and respiratory challenges studies and coordinates additional testing through Children's Center services. This complete and integrated approach provides stability to patients and families, ensuring they feel supported in every way.

Cystic fibrosis is a lifelong condition that requires a combination of inpatient and outpatient services, at-home care and community support. Through education and training, including an annual meeting to share the latest CF research, the center helps families learn about CF and care for their child at home. The center also provides information and referrals to support groups and other community resources.



The Cystic Fibrosis Clinic is approved by California Children Services and accredited by the National Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. The center is actively involved in research and clinical trials to find new and better treatments for cystic fibrosis. It offers a national research study of patients with cystic fibrosis that monitors pulmonary function, pulmonary exacerbations and the efficacy of long-term treatment with Pulmozyme.

All clinical services require a physician referral.
